NOTICE OF RACE

1 Rules

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-2024* as amended by the Sailing Instructions.

2 Advertising

Advertising is restricted as follows: Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the Organising authority.

3 Eligibility and Entry

- 3.1 The event is open to the following classes:

Sabots, Flying II, Laser, Cherub, OK Dinghy, WASZP, Hartley TSI6, Yachts.

- 3.2 The organising authority reserves the right to split the fleet into two or restrict the number of entries in order to preserve the safety of competitors and provide fairness and enjoyment to all participants.

- 3.3 All entrants must present a copy of their valid third-party liability insurance certificate with a minimum cover of AUD\$10,000,000.

- 3.4 Eligible boats will be able to enter online at <https://www.trybooking.com/CTCZX>

- 3.5 Entries will be accepted up to midnight 14th September 2024.

4 Fees

Fees are as follows:

Sabots \$20 per boat.

All other entries \$30 per boat.

5 Schedule

- 5.1 Racing shall commence not before 11:00 hrs.

- 5.2 No warning signal will be made after 1600 hrs.

6 Measurement and Registration

- 6.1 Boats and their equipment, including their safety equipment, may be measured and/or inspected at any time during the regatta by a delegate of the Organising Authority.

7 Sailing Instructions

Sailing Instructions will be made available at <https://www.dsc.org.au/drummoyne-cup-2024/> in due course. The Sailing instructions will describe the courses, penalty system, scoring system, information regarding support boats and their berthing, prizes and other information relating to the regatta.

8 Venue

10 Disclaimer of Liability & Risk Warning

- 10.1 This Risk Warning is issued jointly by Drummoyne Sailing Club and NSW Roads & Maritime Services, pursuant to the Civil Liability Act 2002 to all persons wishing to participate in this event.
- 10.2 Competitors participate entirely at their own risk. RRS 3, Decision to Race states “the responsibility for a boat’s decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone.”
- 10.3 The Organising Authority and NSW Roads & Maritime Services, their directors, officers, volunteers and sponsors:
 - (a) will not accept any liability for damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after this event; and
 - (b) shall not be responsible for the seaworthiness of any boat whose entry is accepted, the adequacy of its equipment or its insurance arrangements.
- 10.4 Participants are warned that, regardless of the precautions which might be taken by reasonable and experienced persons, sailing can be a dangerous pursuit and participants are exposed to significant risk of property damage, physical harm and possibly death. These risks may include, but are not limited to:
 - The extremes of weather and sea conditions;
 - The potential that control of vessels may be lost, resulting in collisions;
 - The sudden movement of the vessel at any time and the possibility that participants may fall or be thrown over board; The possibility that participants may be injured by equipment on the vessel;
 - The absence of immediate medical care and the likelihood that significant delays may occur before medical care is available; Exposure to the elements for extended periods.
- 10.5 The Organising Authority and NSW Roads & Maritime Services jointly warn participants that regardless of their best intentions, they may be unable to render assistance to participants who are in distress.
- 10.6 Participants are warned to consider all risks before deciding to participate in any sailing event.

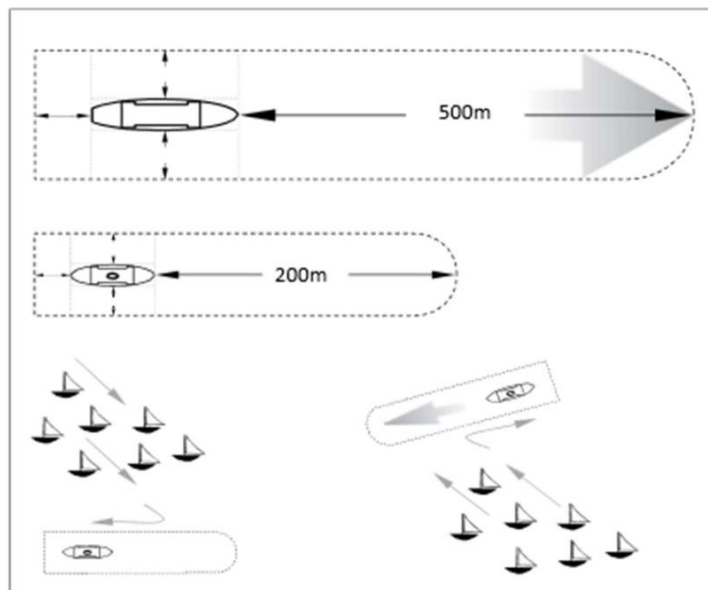
Ship & Ferry Activated Exclusion Zone

(NSW RMS Exemption Order Condition 100)

Additional Conditions for Sailing Events

All competitors must maintain a minimum distance of 500m from the bow of any ship¹ and 200m from the bow of any ferry² and no less than 30m from the sides/stern of any ship or ferry underway.

Failure to do so will result in disqualification.
